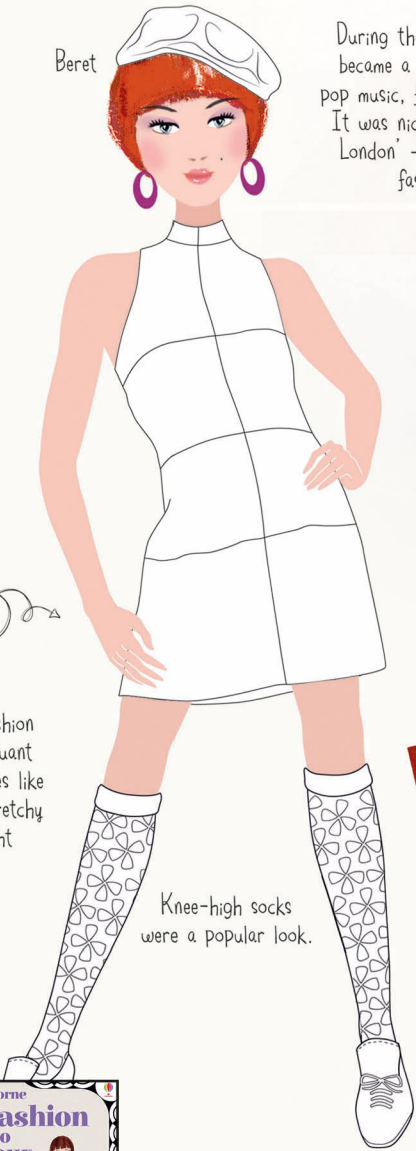


Swinging London

During the sixties, London became a creative hub for pop music, fashion and design. It was nicknamed 'swinging London' - meaning hip or fashionable.



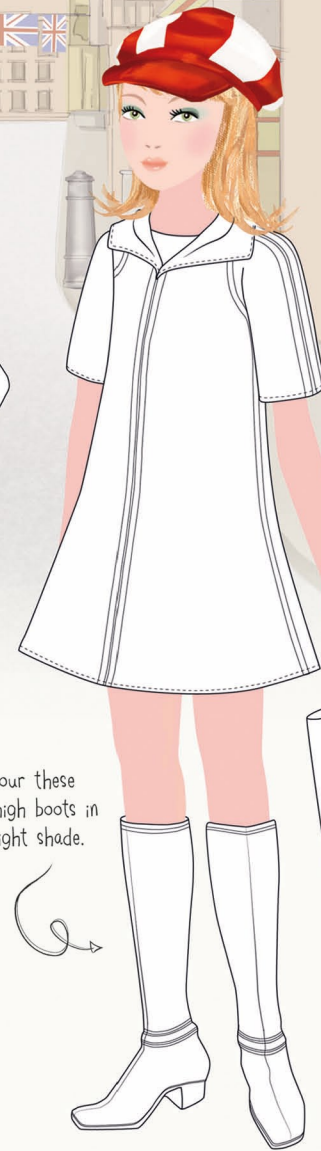
Knee-high socks were a popular look.
