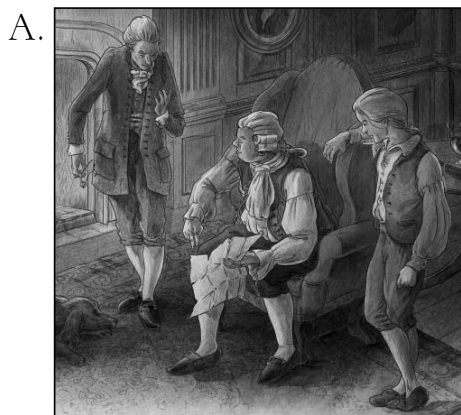

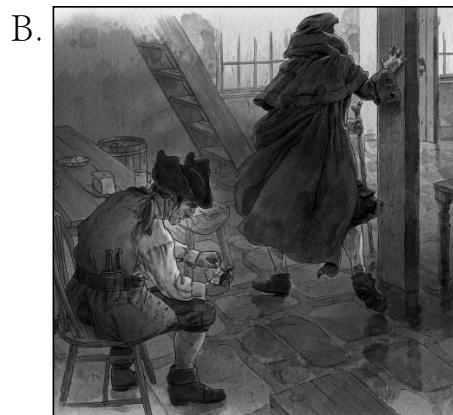

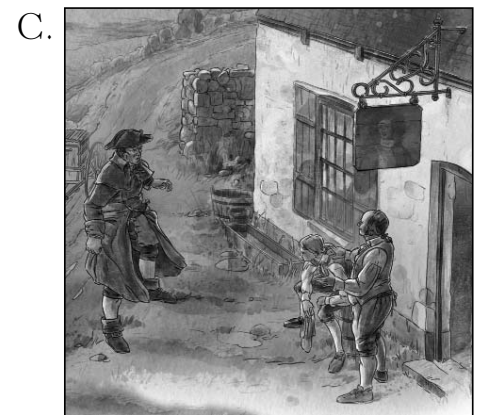
Can you put these pictures and sentences in the right order?



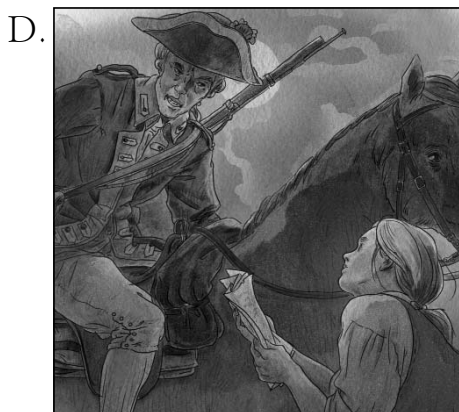
“Just imagine finding the treasure,” said the Squire.



“The black spot!” said Bones. “They’re coming for me!”



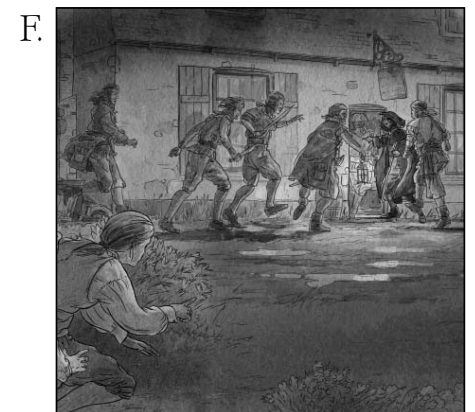
“Do you have many visitors?” said the stranger.
