

BECOME A WILD ARTIST

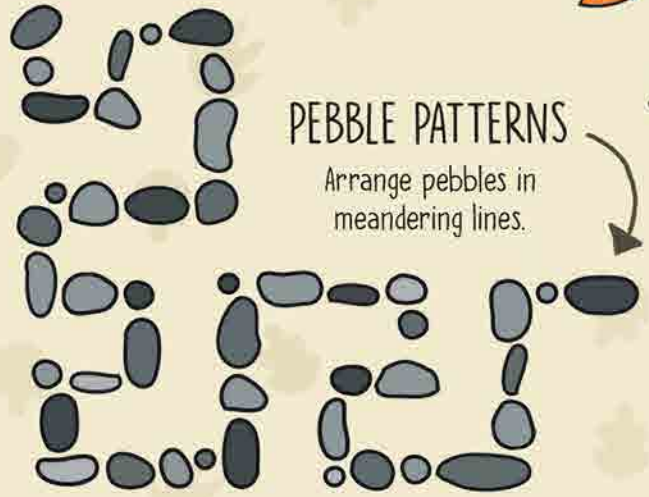
Make wild works of art using leaves, sticks, pebbles, sand or mud next time you're outside.



LEAF CIRCLES

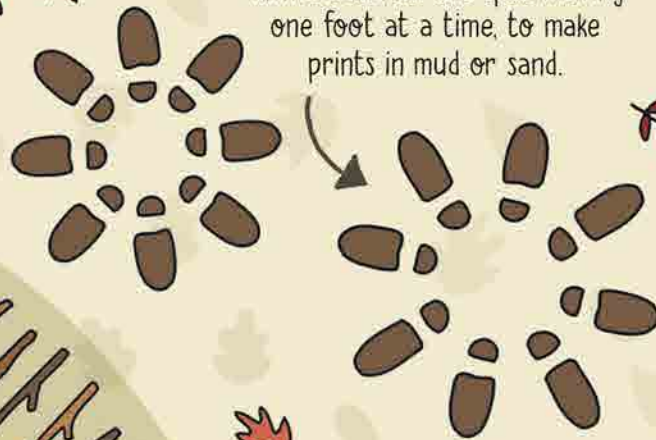
Use fallen leaves to make circular, starburst patterns.

! Don't pick leaves while they're still on a tree.



PEBBLE PATTERNS

Arrange pebbles in meandering lines.



FOOTPRINT FLOWERS

Turn around on the spot moving one foot at a time, to make prints in mud or sand.

PENGUIN PRINTS

Walk with your feet pointing at angles, like a penguin.

BARK RUBBING

Place a piece of paper against a tree trunk and rub over it with a wax crayon.



Now use all the different techniques together to make a BIG work of outdoor art.



STICK LINES

You could create patterns with twigs you find on the ground.
